

FAQ About *Kingdom Builders*

What is the difference between Tithe & Kingdom Builders? The Tithe represents our first fruits—the first 10% of our income that we return to God in faith, trusting that He can accomplish more with 90% than we ever could with 100%. By being faithful to the Tithe, you fuel the direct ministry of our local church, enabling it to thrive and grow.

Kingdom Builders isn't an external organization; it's a community of generous individuals within our church who choose to go above and beyond the Tithe. They step into a realm of generosity to fund global mission projects and help fulfill the Great Commission.

Kingdom Builders is activated after the Tithe (10%) and is the one “bucket” you can give toward to support various ministry outlets, both locally and globally.

Why should I give more than the Tithe? As we faithfully bring the Tithe and give generously through Kingdom Builders, we trust that God will move powerfully in our lives. As a church, we don't give to get—that's not our motivation. Instead, we give with confidence, knowing that God is our provider.

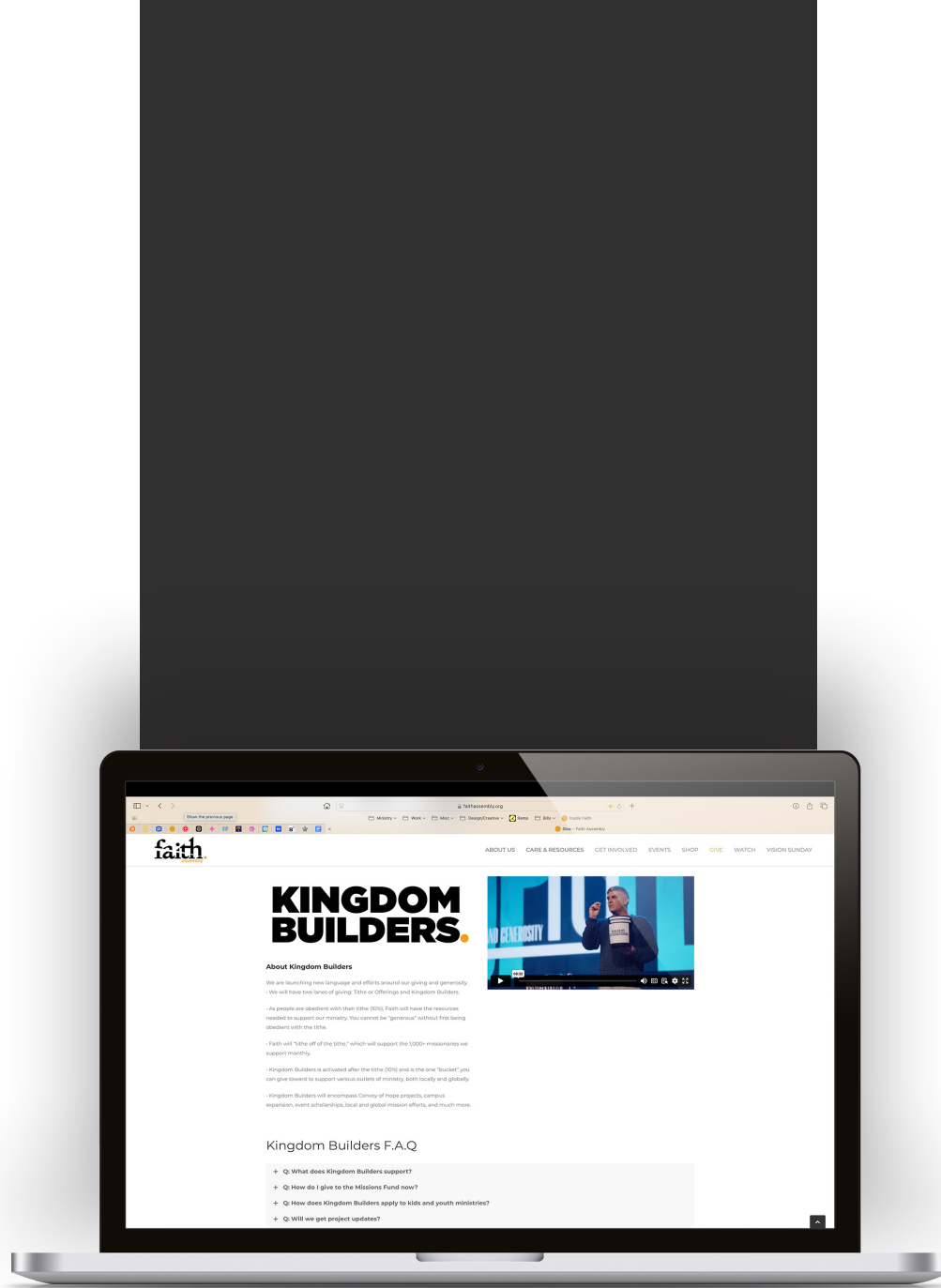
In 2 Corinthians 9:11, Paul reminds us: “You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion...” As followers of Christ, we are blessed to be a blessing. Our generosity not only meets needs but also brings glory to God, resulting in thanksgiving to Him.

What does the money given toward Kingdom Builders go to? Through Kingdom Builders, we invest in local and global ministries dedicated to reaching the lost,

servicing the poor, and transforming lives while advancing God's kingdom. We proudly partner with reputable organizations like Builders International, Convoy of Hope, Live Dead, Teen Challenge, and many other initiatives committed to spreading the gospel to all nations.

How do we decide as a church what projects to support? Our decisions are guided by several key commitments. As a Pentecostal organization, we prioritize supporting Assemblies of God initiatives in our missionary efforts. Recognizing that only 1.7% of global missions funding currently reaches the unreached, and with 42% of the world still without access to the Gospel, a significant portion of our missions fund is dedicated to frontline workers in the most challenging areas. We also support local projects that stem from established ministry partnerships we trust, which have proven to yield great fruit. Additionally, missionaries can apply for funding, allowing specific projects and emerging needs to be considered for support.

Who can be a Kingdom Builder? The greatest part about this lane of giving is that anyone can be a Kingdom Builder! By giving even one penny above the Tithe, you start becoming a Kingdom Builder and join together with our church to partner with other churches and organizations around the world in what God is doing.



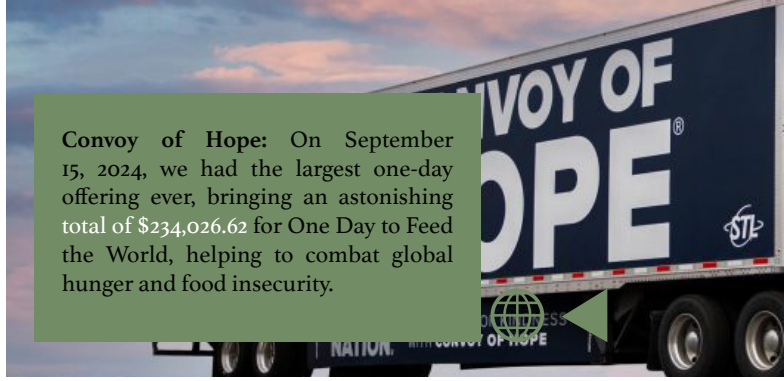

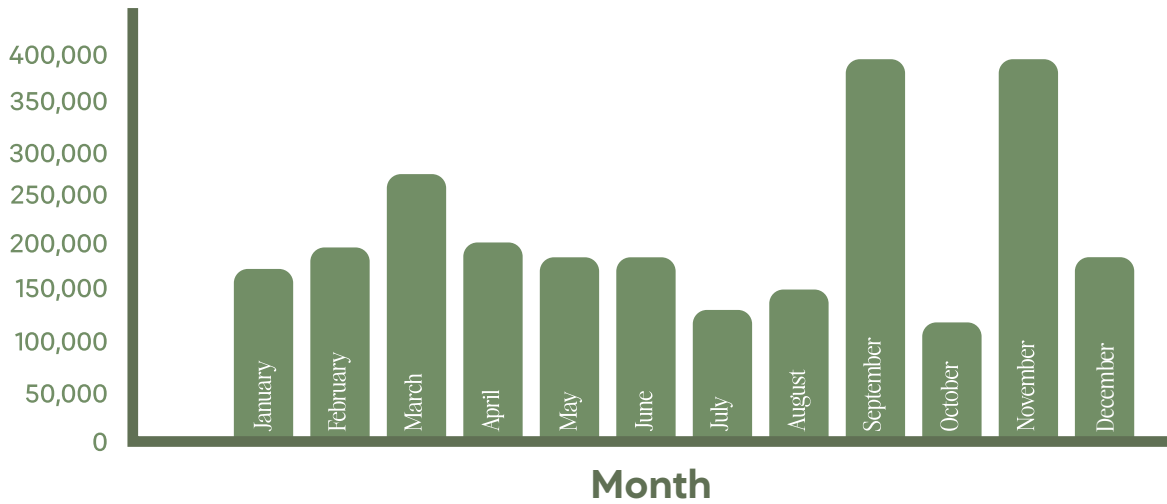

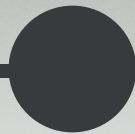

Technology. Transportation. Innovation. These words come to mind when I think about Speed the Light, an organization committed to mobilizing the Gospel. Saying “yes” to becoming a missionary involves many steps—from training and receiving assignments to fundraising and finally making it to the field. But arriving in their assigned country is only half the journey. A new set of needs must be met before missionaries can fully engage in ministry, and this is where Speed the Light comes in.

As one of our Kingdom Builders partners, Speed the Light is a missions initiative that provides missionaries with funds to purchase transportation upon arriving at their destination. It also supports churches and pastors with tools to advance the Gospel. These needs can include funding a sound system for the International Church in Japan (so the Gospel can be heard louder) or equipping Egyptian pastors with Kindles loaded with ministry training resources. What sets Speed the Light apart is its partnership with hundreds of youth ministries like ours, empowering students to fund the mission and literally speed the light of the Gospel. Across the U.S., middle and high school students are challenged to raise money to help share the Gospel around the world.

One practical way we support this effort is by challenging every student to contribute \$100 during our end-of-year campaign. Many students rise to the occasion through creative fundraising, such as selling baked goods, crafting, or sacrificing luxuries like coffee trips or new sneakers. This past fall, one middle school student exceeded the challenge. After raising her initial \$100 by selling homemade baked goods, she continued seeking donations, eventually receiving a \$500 contribution. Her hard work resulted in \$600 raised for Kingdom Builders, and our team was so proud of her accomplishment. This is a testament to how Kingdom Builders initiatives inspire individuals to go above and beyond in their generosity.

Over the past 20 years, Mainstream has purchased more than 15 vehicles for missionaries serving in regions from South America to Asia. These efforts align with the larger mission of Kingdom Builders to support global ministries. For example, Fred and Terry Sanchez, missionaries and members of Faith Assembly, received their “white knight”—a four-door SUV that enables them to transport ministry materials from church to church in Guatemala. In 2016, we purchased a military Hummer for David Houck to pioneer a ministry in the Ocala National Forest, reaching children living in extreme poverty.

We’ve also funded a surveillance van for FREE International, which rescues children and teens from sex trafficking in the U.S., and vehicles for Faith Assembly missionaries Ken and Tiffany Belbin, Michael and Cara Montalvo, and Heather Hawks—all before they even reached the field.

The impact of these projects on our students is immeasurable. As a youth team, we’re grateful to empower young people to practice generosity in such a practical way. My hope is that Mainstream students will continue growing in their generosity, ensuring that missionaries have every vehicle or resource they need without delay. Thanks to Kingdom Builders, we can continue advancing the Gospel through strategic partnerships and innovative solutions. More importantly, as we advance the Gospel in innovative ways, we inspire a generation eager to embrace innovation while meeting the needs of those who have left everything behind for the sake of the Gospel.

A Reach Local Story

At Reach Local, the phrase “Bringing hope to the neighborhood” represents more than a tagline—it embodies our mission and purpose. In a world filled with brokenness and need, we recognize the critical importance of stepping beyond the walls of the church and meeting people exactly where they are. This is the heart of our ministry: to demonstrate the love of God through action, compassion, and presence.

The Bible reminds us in James 1:27 that, “Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.” This verse challenges us to live out our faith in ways that are practical and deeply impactful. At Reach Local, we have taken this call to heart, striving to create a ministry that does more than provide for physical needs—it brings hope, healing, and dignity to those we serve.

One of the guiding inspirations behind this mission comes from the words of Saint Teresa of Ávila: “Christ has no body but yours, no hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on this world.”

These words are a powerful reminder that we are called to be Christ’s representatives here on earth. It is through our actions, not just our words, that people encounter His love. The story of the Good Samaritan is a powerful illustration of this principle. As Jesus taught, loving our neighbor means going beyond what is expected, stepping out of our comfort zones, and engaging directly with the needs of others. This story continues to inspire our work at Reach Local.

Let me share a modern reflection of this parable. Lisa, a young mother of two, found herself homeless after escaping an abusive relationship. With nowhere to turn and her hope dwindling, she wandered into one of our community outreach events. Our team met her with open arms, offering not just resources, but genuine care. We helped her secure temporary housing, connected her to job opportunities, and provided emotional and spiritual support. Most importantly, we reminded Lisa that she was not alone—that she was seen, valued, and deeply loved by God.

Today, Lisa's life is on a new trajectory. Her story is a testament to the transformative power of love in action. And while her journey is uniquely her own, it represents the heart of Reach Local: to bring hope to individuals in their most vulnerable moments and to walk alongside them as they rebuild their lives.

At its core, Reach Local is about more than benevolence. It is about relational ministry—a commitment to truly knowing and understanding the people we serve. This is why our approach emphasizes conversational evangelism. Sharing the gospel is not about preaching from a distance but about engaging in meaningful, personal interactions. It's about listening, connecting, and showing others through our actions that God's love is real and present in their lives.

The mission of Reach Local is a shared responsibility. As believers, we are all called to embody the love of Christ in the way we interact with our neighbors. Whether through a kind word, a helping hand, or simply being present, every act of compassion has the potential to change a life. Just as the Good Samaritan stopped to care for a stranger in need, we too must be willing to pause, step in, and make a difference.

Bringing hope to the neighborhood is not merely an initiative—it is a reflection of our faith in action. At Reach Local, we are honored to be part of this transformative work, and we invite you to join us in making an impact. Making a Difference, One Care Package at a Time:

Alex Bonilla's Impact on Our Community

Faith, compassion, and action—these are the driving forces behind Alex Bonilla's ministry. As a dedicated volunteer who leads one of Faith Assembly's Reach Local teams, Alex has been instrumental in serving the homeless in Downtown Orlando. For the past four years, Alex and his team have provided meals, care packages, and hope to the most vulnerable in our city.

A Ministry of Compassion and Impact

Reflecting on his journey, Alex shared, "For the needy shall not always be forgotten, the expectation of the poor shall not perish forever" (Psalm 9:18). This Scripture encapsulates the heart of this Reach Local Team. Over two days, Alex and 73 volunteers prepared and distributed 400 care packages and lunches to the homeless—a feat fueled by faith and community support.

The ministry extends beyond food and clothing. Volunteers distribute Bibles, offering spiritual nourishment alongside physical sustenance. "We are trying to make a difference in the community. God is good," Alex shared.

Mobilizing the Church for Service

Every outreach begins with preparation. On November 15, 55 volunteers gathered to assemble sandwiches, care packages, and donations. The following morning, 18 volunteers from Faith distributed items at Lake Eola, making personal connections in the community and reflecting Christ's love in action.

A highlight of the year was a partnership with Omar Aguila, a member of Faith who empowered his workplace to collect 171 pairs of socks during "Socktober" to give towards Reach Local's efforts.


A Kingdom Builder's Generosity

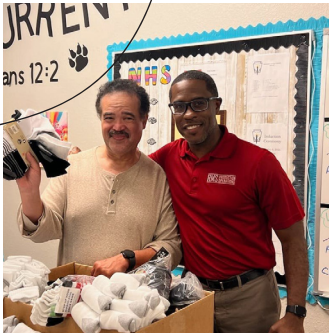

Two members of our church family, Daphne Rivera and Dr. Christina Angelakos, recently embarked on such journeys—Daphne to the Middle East and Christina to Argentina—where they saw firsthand how giving through Kingdom Builders is transforming lives.

In Argentina, Dr. Angelakos traveled with King's Castle, an Assemblies of God organization bringing the Gospel to villages across Latin America. She shared, "Walking through narrow, trash-filled streets with a local pastor, I was struck by her unwavering love for the community." Despite the difficult surroundings, this pastor's focus was on the people.

"She knew every child's name," Dr. Angelakos recalled. "One by one, she called out their names: 'Sofia!' 'John!' 'Emma!' Each child came running, their faces lit with joy, as if invited into a world of love and belonging." Inside the church, these children received food, Bible lessons, and a symbolic crown—a reminder that they are loved by God.

"In that moment, it struck me: this is how Jesus loves us. He calls us by name, no matter where we are or how broken we feel. He meets us in the mess of our lives," Dr. Angelakos shared. Moments like these remind us that our giving extends God's love to others.

Moments like these are a humbling reminder that our giving can help extend that same love to others. Walking in those streets and seeing Kingdom Builders funds at work through one of our partners, AGWM, challenged Christina to love more sacrificially and to give more generously. While Christina's journey in Argentina highlights the power of love and belonging, Daphne Rivera's experience in the Middle East reveals the resilience of faith under fire.

Meanwhile, in the Middle East, Daphne Rivera's journey with Live Dead: Arab World revealed the resilience of faith under persecution. "Walking through the streets of this beautiful country, I was struck by the warmth and generosity of its people," Daphne shared.

In a small church surrounded by refugees, she listened as they shared heartbreaking stories of loss—homes destroyed, families separated, and lives uprooted by war. Yet amidst it all, their faith remained unwavering.

“Instead of fear or despair, their suffering had deepened their faith. Their courage and perseverance were a living testimony of what it means to truly carry your cross,” Rivera shared.

She also encountered moments that redefined compassion. While walking through a neighborhood, children ran toward their group, grabbing food they intended to eat. Initially, it felt like theft, but the missionaries showed her a different perspective: the children were desperate, not mischievous.

“Where we saw theft, they saw brokenness. Where we felt offense, they felt compassion,” Rivera shared. “They treated the children as precious souls in need of love, showing me how pride blinds us to others’ pain and how the Gospel calls us to respond differently.”

Both trips underscored a vital truth: mission work isn’t just about what we can give but how it changes us. Whether in Buenos Aires or the Middle East, stepping into these spaces reveals the depth of need and the incredible ways God is working through our giving.

Through Kingdom Builders, Faith Assembly supports organizations like AGWM and Live Dead, empowering pastors, reaching refugees, and sharing the Gospel in hard-to-reach places. Every act of giving fuels these efforts, and every trip reminds us why it matters.

Witnessing the impact firsthand stirred a new sense of responsibility in Daphne, Christina, and their teams. These trips don’t just inspire us to give—they reveal how much more we can do when we give sacrificially. If you’ve ever wondered whether you should go on a mission trip, the answer is simple: go. Experience the stories, see the need, and let your heart be transformed. Let your going inspire your giving, and together, we’ll continue to build the Kingdom.

A Reach Global Trip Story

As a Pastor and missionary, I've had the privilege of witnessing countless moments that redefine hope—stories of lives touched and transformed by the Gospel. But one of the most profound journeys of my life has been sharing the love of Jesus with the Deaf community. This ministry has opened my eyes to God's boundless love in ways I never imagined, teaching me that inclusivity and celebrating culture are powerful tools for advancing God's Kingdom. It's a story of faith, hope, and how the Gospel can reach hearts in their own language. This is where Kingdom Builders plays a key role—supporting initiatives like these that go beyond borders and languages to bring the message of Christ to those who need it most.

The Deaf community is far more than a group defined by physical limitations—it's a tapestry of rich culture, pride, and unique identity. Deafness is often embraced not as a disability but as a defining aspect of one's being, with American Sign Language (ASL) serving as the cornerstone of this vibrant culture. ASL is more than a means of communication—it reflects shared experiences and offers a window into how the Deaf engage with the world.

Embracing this beautiful culture has not only transformed my ministry but also deepened my understanding of God's heart for all people. Psalm 139:13-14 reminds us, "For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made." Each of us is fearfully, wonderfully, and purposefully created—including the Deaf.

Our mission is clear: to bring the Gospel to the Deaf in ways that affirm their identity and celebrate their culture. By learning ASL, building relationships, and honoring their stories, we've found meaningful ways to share the love of Christ. When we reflect God's love by truly seeing and valuing people, walls come down, and hearts are opened.

For the Deaf, faith often comes not by hearing, but by seeing and understanding. The American Sign Language Version (ASLV) of the Bible is a groundbreaking tool that makes Scripture accessible in their heart language. For many who struggle with English literacy, the ASLV has been a game-changer, opening the door to God's Word like never before. Seeing Deaf individuals connect with the Gospel in ASL is breathtaking—their eyes light up, their hearts engage, and the message of hope comes alive. As Ephesians 3:20 declares, "Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine..." Truly, God's power knows no bounds.

At Faith Assembly in Orlando, Florida, our Deaf and Interpreter Ministry is growing in extraordinary ways. Through discipleship programs like Grow Classes tailored for Deaf individuals, we've equipped many to deepen their faith and step into leadership roles. Today, Deaf individuals are not just participants in ministry—they are leaders, teachers, and evangelists, reaching their peers in ways only they can.

In August 2024, we took a team of 12 people—Deaf leaders, interpreters, and hearing allies—to Honduras to bring the Gospel to a Deaf school. What we encountered was nothing short of inspiring. The school, managed by selfless Pastors who have dedicated their lives to empowering Deaf students, is a beacon of hope. Some students travel hours to attend, and teachers are often parents or alumni who have committed to shaping the next generation.

One of the highlights of our trip was hosting Camp We Sign Honduras, an offsite retreat for 52 Deaf children. Through lessons and activities focused on the principles that God made us, loves us, helps us, and is with us, we witnessed remarkable growth—not just in the children but in our team as well. Bonds were strengthened, faith was deepened, and several team members felt a call to leadership and missions.

The Deaf community represents an often-overlooked mission field, yet the harvest is plentiful. As Joshua 1:9 reminds us, “Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.” God is indeed with us, equipping and guiding us as we reach hearts in the language that speaks most deeply to them.

I invite you to join us in this extraordinary mission. Whether through prayer, financial support, or hands-on involvement, your partnership through Kingdom Builders ensures that ministries like this one continue to thrive. Together, we can ensure the Deaf hear the Gospel—not through sound, but through the unmistakable message of God’s love in their language and culture. Let’s build the Kingdom, one life at a time, and celebrate the truth that every voice, every language, and every heart matters deeply to God.
